

Clinical Improvement Coordinator (1.0 FTE)

Based in Spruce Grove, WestView Primary Care Network is Alberta's 2nd Primary Care Network (PCN). Working collaboratively with family physicians the PCN strengthens primary health care delivery in the communities of Spruce Grove, Stony Plain, and Parkland County.

PCN's are intended to increase patient access to primary care, improve care coordination, foster a team approach, increase the focus of health promotion, and improve care for people with chronic disease.

We are currently recruiting a **Clinical Improvement Coordinator (CIC) (1.0 FTE – 38.75 hours/week)** who will engage and support member family practice clinics of the PCN in the undertakings of PCN-led improvement initiatives (e.g. Alberta Screening and Prevention and Alberta *Access Improvement Measurement*, among others). The **CIC** will assist clinic teams in maximizing the opportunities/efficiencies at the clinic level in process improvement; and develop implementation strategies to sustain positive changes within the clinic setting. The **CIC** will have experience managing/leading change management and process re-design, knowledge of improvement and change methodology and their practical applications in a health care setting, experience working with clinical professionals and/or physicians. The successful candidate will have a good knowledge of primary healthcare in Alberta, excellent verbal and written communication skills, demonstrated project management skills and knowledge of information technology and electronic medical records. A Baccalaureate degree or diploma in a related field of study (health discipline preferred). Equivalencies of education and experience will be considered.
