Your Opportunity:

Reporting to the Executive Director and working closely with the Medical Director and Quality Improvement team, the Quality Improvement and Evaluation Facilitator is a champion for change working collaboratively with family physicians, clinic managers, and WVPCN staff. The Quality Improvement and Evaluation Facilitator works closely with the Practice Facilitator to assess member clinic and centralized clinic readiness for quality improvement, and plan, implement, and evaluate clinical improvement projects that target improvements in population health and optimize the Patient's Medical Home.

The Quality Improvement and Evaluation Facilitator will lead the implementation of the WVPCN Evaluation Framework, working closely with the Quality Improvement team, and will support research activities on behalf of the Westview Non-Profit Corporation and Evaluation and Research Subcommittee of the WVPCN Board, as required.

Description:

You will work collaboratively to support implementation, evaluation, and reporting on quality improvement projects. This role is instrumental in: managing moderate to complex evidence gathering and evaluation projects; providing sound project management including: scoping, designing and implementing scientifically sound investigations, and analysis and reporting; applying best practices related to research and evaluation methodology, theory and practice; establishing and sustaining positive and effective working relationships with member clinics and centralized program teams; performing intermediate to advanced analysis and reporting that influences operational decision-making, strategic planning, program development and practice improvement; and mitigating risks by



ensuring the quality and integrity of results and ethical oversight of the highest quality.

Qualifications:

Undergraduate degree with a strong quantitative and qualitative component in a related field, e.g., health promotion, social sciences, public health, or other related fields.

Additional Required Qualifications:

Formal training in project evaluation and/or research methods and data analysis. Change management and / or project management education or experience. A minimum of two years of experience within a healthcare environment is required. Proficiency in written and verbal communication is essential. Proficiency in qualitative and quantitative methods is required.
